**Crystal Crown Series Year-End Awards**

- Overall Top 20; must compete in 3 of 4 rides.
- Seniors Top 2 (ages 65 and over); must compete in 2 of 4 rides.
- Juniors Top 2 (ages 13-17); must compete in 2 of 4 rides.
- Youth Top 2 (ages 12 and under); must compete in 2 of 4 rides.
- Novice Rider (competed in 3 or fewer JPRs as of 4/1); must compete in 2 of 4 rides.
- Riders may qualify for year-end awards in more than one division but must meet the eligibility requirements and ride the required number of rides for each division placed.
- If Seniors, Juniors, Youths, and Novice Rider wish to compete in Overall Top 20, they must compete in 3 of 4 rides.
- Riders may not qualify for more than one award within a division.

**Reminders of Crystal Crown Rules**

1. If a rider has competed in 3 JPRs or less as of the first CC, he/she will be classified as a Novice for the duration of the CC Series. This division will also be included in year-end awards for qualifying riders. Note that rider must compete on the same horse to qualify.
2. For each ride in which a participant signs up, pays, and rides, said rider/horse team will be awarded an additional 5 points. To have considered as having rode the ride, the participant must attempt at least one obstacle at the ride. Said points will be added to the post-season cumulative score versus the final score for each JPR. This equates to the rider/horse team having the ability to earn an additional 20 year-end points if they participate in all four (4) rides.
3. Year-end awards are based on rider/horse teams. Riders must ride the same horse to qualify for year-end awards. Riders may qualify on one horse only within a division.
